

Ethics Committee Annual Report 2025

Introduction

The Ethics Committee continued its work in 2025 in accordance with its mandate to promote ethical standards, academic integrity, and a culture of responsible conduct within the university community. The Committee's activities focused on strengthening ethical awareness among employees and students, fostering a transparent and respectful academic environment, and supporting the implementation of institutional ethics policies.

Committee Meetings

During the reporting period, the Ethics Committee held two official meetings:

- 18 March 2025
- 17 April 2025

The meetings addressed issues related to the development of an ethical culture within the university, implementation of educational initiatives, and enhancement of awareness regarding ethical standards and academic integrity. Committee members discussed current challenges, reviewed planned activities, and identified priorities for further strengthening ethics governance across the institution.

Educational and Awareness Activities

As part of the implementation of the Ethics Committee Action Plan, an educational seminar-training entitled “Academic Integrity and Ethics in the University Environment” was organized and conducted.

The seminar provided participants with an opportunity to enhance their understanding of ethical principles and responsible behavior in academic and professional settings. The program included:

- Overview of the fundamental principles of corporate and academic ethics;
- Analysis of practical case studies involving ethical dilemmas;
- Discussion of mechanisms for preventing ethical violations and misconduct;
- Explanation of procedures and available channels for submitting concerns, complaints, and ethical inquiries.

The event was attended by university employees and students and served as an important platform for dialogue and awareness-building.

Key Outcomes

- Increased awareness among employees and students regarding ethical standards, academic integrity, and responsible conduct;
